## **Company at Brief**



PT Triniti Dinamik Tbk is a real estate and property developer company in Indonesia. Since the establishment in 2014, two major projects are Springwood Residence with 1,400 units and The Smith that consists of Office, SOHO, and Residential with 652 units. After successfully building two High Rise Building projects, the Company is currently developing landed houses that are integrated with the area, namely the District East project located in East Karawang with a land area of around 26 Ha.

One of the strengths of Triniti Dinamik is the fast speed selling capability. Springwood Residence was able to be sold out in less than 6 (six) months. As for The Smith's sales, until the end of 2023 has reached 85%. PT Triniti Dinamik Tbk is part of PT Perintis Triniti Properti Tbk who also developed projects in Alam Sutera including: Brooklyn, Yukata Suites, and Collins Boulevard, with the total project value amounted to nearly US\$1 billion.

The Company is supported by professional Management who is able to provide high quality premium and high-class project. With the certification of ISO 9001, proper quality system and corporate good governance have been implemented strictly. Therefore, the majority of customers remain satisfied with what has been delivered by the Company through its projects.

#### a. CSR Impact



#### b. ESG Efforts

Our focus on Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG) aspects is at the heart of our sustainability journey. We recognize the importance of responsible resource management and have implemented significant measures to reduce our ecological footprint. Our initiatives include the efficient use of paper, with a total consumption of 105 reams during 9M 2024, alongside 9,143 liters of fuel and 30,988 kWh of electricity during the same period. These efforts are complemented by our rigorous waste management practices to further minimize environmental impact.



### **Paper Usage by Project**



The chart beside this displays the paper usage table for each project under Triniti Dinamik. It indicates that the total paper usage reached 105 reams in 9M 2024. Currently, the Springwood Residence (SW) and The Smith (TS) projects are combined as the largest contributors, with a total paper usage of 105 reams. Meanwhile, the District East (DE) project has not recorded any paper usage in this table as it is a new project still in the early stages of development, and therefore does not yet require a significant amount of paper.

### **Fuel Usage by Project**


(Liter)



The chart on the side illustrates fuel usage by Triniti Dinamik and its projects. This chart reflects that the total fuel usage in 9M 2024 reached 9.144 liters. Additionally, the chart indicates that the combined fuel usage in Springwood Residence (SW) and The Smith (TS) is the highest, amounting to 5.722 liters. This is due to the numerous exhibitions held outside the projects, which has resulted in a more frequent need for office vehicle use. To reduce its carbon footprint, Triniti Dinamik is committed to saving fuel by transporting 6-8 people from the head office to various projects.

## **Electricity Usage by Project**

The chart on the side illustrates electricity usage by Triniti Dinamik and its projects. The total electricity usage across all Triniti Dinamik projects for 9M 2024 amounted to 30.998 kWh, with the consumption fully accounted for by Springwood Residence (SW) and The Smith (TS). District East (DE) is still under construction and therefore has not been included in the electricity records.
